Perspective:

A resurrected life

After His resurrection, Jesus appeared to His disciples and said, in Luke 24:45-48 NKJV - "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

A resurrected life is a life built on forgiveness, repentance, and honoring God. Jesus commanded that His disciples preach repentance and forgiveness in His name, and to all nations. The disciples were blessed with the perfect example of how to live a godly life.

Jesus demonstrated what it is to live as a follower with belief in the one true God, and to "do justice, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with our God" (Micah 6:8).

Our relationship with each other and God is a daily choice.

Do justice (caring for those who cannot care for themselves), love mercy (love even those who hate you) and walk humbly with God (live in daily obedience to the Father).

As you reflect on Who Jesus is, remember, the chains of death have lost their grip. Jesus is no longer in the tomb — live a resurrected life!
