Perspective:

“Until He Comes”

Our responsibility until He returns. Luke 19:13 KJV - And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, **Occupy till I come.**

“Occupy till I come” What does this word “occupy” mean? It does not mean “take up space.” It does not mean, “wait,” or “occupy your recliner until I return.” Nor does it mean, “hang around till I return.” No, this word does not describe passiveness.

He is telling them to **“Take care of business”** keep busy until I return.

The emphasis of the Lord in His parable is don’t worry about the future kingdom; take care of business today.

He would soon leave them and at the appointed time He would receive His kingdom from His Father. Meanwhile, they were given a great work to do, and He had given them what they needed to occupy (do business) until he returned.

The citizens of the Kingdom hated the nobleman. John 1:11 **“He came unto his own, and his own received him not.”** This world hates King Jesus and views with contempt the idea that He would reign over them. The world doesn’t mind the baby Jesus in a cradle, and they don’t have a problem with a dead Jesus hanging on a cross.
