He began by reminding the Gentile Christians about their lives prior to Jesus. He asked them to remember what they once were. As Gentiles, they experienced a four-fold alienation.

"Until He Comes" "...Occupy till I come." Luke 19:13b

“circumcision” (Jews) “uncircumcision” (Gentiles) (Rom. 2:25-29; Gal. 5:6; 6:15). Those who have trusted Christ have received a spiritual circumcision “**made without hands**” (Col. 2:11).

Once We Were Far Off, Now We Are Near Ephesian 2:11-13

1. Gentiles were segregated socially. Ephesians 2:11b NKJV
They were “**called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision”**

2. Gentiles were separated spiritually. Ephesians 2:12a NKJV
– “**at that time you were without Christ”**

3. Gentiles were isolated nationally. Ephesians 2:12b, c NKJV
- Paul called the Gentiles “**...aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise...”**

4. Gentiles were alienated personally. Ephesians 2:12d NKJV
– “**having no hope and without God in the world.”**

5. But God. Ephesians 2:13 NKJV - “**But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.”**

Hebrews 6:19 NLT - “**Hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary”**
