Annual Church Ministry Report Sunday March 29, 2026

"Forget the former things...I am doing a new thing!" Isaiah 43:18-19"

Join us as we look at the story of Mary anointing Jesus' feet in Mark 14:1-11 and learn five characteristics of having a deep love for Christ. Our hope is that this message would encourage you to cultivate a passionate love for the Lord.

This likely takes place on Wednesday of the last week of Jesus earthly ministry...

Here Mark is setting up the betrayal of Jesus then he moves to a story about Jesus at Bethany...

Here are some questions to think about as we look at this story together:

Do you love Jesus?

How much do you love Him?

Do you love Him as much as you should?

Do you love Him as much as you could?

1- Deep love for Jesus worships. (Mark 14:3; John 12:1-3)

2- Deep love for Jesus is extravagant. (Mark 14:3-5)

3- Deep love for Jesus isn't worried about what others will think. (Mark 14:4-7; John 12:3-5; 1 Peter 2:9)

4- Deep love for Jesus results in spiritual insight. (Mark 14:8; Mark 9:31; Psalm 25:14)

5- Deep love for Jesus is applauded by God. (Mark 14:9; Psalms 103:1-2)
