Lessons from the Prodigal's Dad

Christ shares about a prodigal son who went off to sow wild oats, before eventually coming to his senses, and returning home in humility to find redemption (Luke 15). While focus is often on the prodigal, valuable application can be gained from a look at the father in the parable and his attitude toward his lost son.

**"Forget the former things...I am doing a new thing!"
Isaiah 43:18-19"**

1. Fathers Cultivate Relationship. (Luke 15:20)

Keep praying and believing for their return, just like the prodigal's father.

He seeks and saves the lost, not desiring that any should go into eternity without Christ, but that all should come to repentance (Luke 19:10; 2 Peter 3:9).

2. Fathers Love Unconditionally. (Luke 15:20)

Godly fathers love their children, blemishes and all.

The prodigal's father reminds us of God's unconditional love.

Though we were sinners, God gave His own son to die on our behalf, that we may be forgiven and spend eternity with Him (Romans 5:1; John 3:16).

Though we are unworthy to even be His servant, through Christ, God adopts us as His children (Romans 8:15; 1 John 3:1).

3. Fathers Demonstrate Affection. (Luke 15:21-22)

It is healthy for dads to show affection to their spouse and kids.

This parable again reminds us that God has lavished His love upon us by making us His children (1 John 3:1)

Our Father has taken away our rags and clothed us in His righteousness (Isaiah 64:6; 61:10).
