## The Holy Spirit is God.

### 1. The Holy Spirit Guides Us into Truth. (Acts 5:1–4)

What does this story tell us about how we should behave with our fellow believers?

Think of people in your life who are honest. What are some of the positive attributes that accompany those who choose to always tell the truth?

### 2. The Holy Spirit Knows Our Thoughts. Acts 5:5–10

Both Ananias and Sapphira had a choice. They could lie or tell the truth.

When someone has opportunity to come clean, what usually keeps them from telling the truth?

Have you experienced a situation where a person in authority wasn't being honest? What happened?

### 3. The Holy Spirit Deserves Our Respect. Acts 5:11

First, we should choose to be people of truth.

Second, we should realize that the Holy Spirit lives in all believers.

Our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19).

How should thinking about fellow believers as the temple of God's Spirit impact how we treat them?

The Holy Spirit is just as much God as the rest of the Trinity (one God existing in a unity of three distinct, divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit).
