**Jesus is My Savior!****1. Peter denies being a follower of Jesus.** (Luke 22:31–61)

Peter failed miserably and betrayed his Friend. Thankfully, Peter's story wasn't over. After Jesus rose from the dead, He appeared to the disciples. This was Peter's chance to be restored.

**2. Jesus Meets Us Where We Are.** (John 21:1–6)

He appears and calls out to us even when we don't recognize Him in our daily life.

What are some practical ways Jesus appears in our life?

Why do you think we sometimes fail to recognize Him?

**3. Salvation Requires Faith in Jesus.** (John 21:7–14)

When did you first recognize who Jesus is and how much He could mean to you?

How might this passage demonstrate the connection between God's blessings and our obedience?

**4. Jesus Forgives Those Who Love Him.** (John 21:15–19)

How does this passage show the extent of Jesus' forgiveness?

Why do you think many people have trouble believing Jesus forgives those who love and accept Him, no matter what they've done?

**5. Jesus Is My Savior!** (John 3:16)

In what ways did Jesus appear along the way—perhaps long before you recognized it was Him?

How has following Jesus led you into a life of greater purpose?
