1. Pursuit of God Requires Right Motivations. Matthew 6:5–8, 16–18

2. Pursuit Requires a Humble Approach. Matthew 6:9-10

He (Jesus) often went off on His own to talk to God (Luke 5:16).

3. Pursuit Requires Open Hands. Matthew 6:11-13

How should our prayer life reflect our need to be changed and not just our desire to see change?

4. Pursuit Requires Forgiving Hearts. Matthew 6:14–15

Jesus taught that those who know they have been forgiven much, love much (Luke 7:47).

What makes it so difficult to forgive others who have hurt us?

How can the gospel (the good news about Jesus) free us to be someone who forgives?
