I Give Generously.

Matthew 6:33 NKJV - “**But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.**”

What did you learn about money from your parents?

How have you seen money be a distraction in someone’s relationship with God?

1. Giving Generously Costs Us Something. (Mark 12:41–44; 2 Samuel 2:22-24)

What does this story tell us about how Jesus viewed giving?

What keeps us from being generous toward others?

2. Giving Generously Starts in the Heart. (Colossians 3:16–17)

When we give, why does the motivation of our heart matter so much?

Have you ever had a wrong heart motivation for giving?

3. Giving Generously Is an Act of Joy. (2 Corinthians 9:6–8; Luke 6:38; 2 Corinthians 9:10–12)

How does viewing our possessions as God’s resources, not our own, enable people to give more generously and joyfully?

4. Giving Generously Goes Beyond the Tithe. (Malachi 3:8–10; Luke 11:42)

Malachi mentioned offerings, giving above and beyond our tithe. What are some ways people might choose to give beyond the tithe?
