We need to understand that when we believe God should choose someone else to accomplish His purposes, we insult Him more than ourselves. This false humility doesn't give God His due credit. Through the Holy Spirit, He can equip each one of us with spiritual gifts to fulfill His mission in unique ways.

The Holy Spirit Equips Us.

1. The Holy Spirit Inspires Us to Take Action. (Acts 8:26–35; Matthew 28:19)

What does this story show us about how the Holy Spirit leads us?

On a scale of one to ten, how would you rate your level of readiness to follow the leading of the Spirit?

How do you think believers could develop more sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's voice and then take action, so others can ultimately hear about Jesus?

2. The Holy Spirit Uses Us All. (Acts 8:36–40)

How does learning that Philip wasn't a pastor make you feel about how the Spirit worked through him?

Do you see a difference between how the Holy Spirit speaks to church leaders and those in the congregation?

In your own life, have you felt the Holy Spirit speak to you to take immediate action?

3. The Holy Spirit Equips Each Person Uniquely. (1 Corinthians 12:7–11)

What is one spiritual gift you have seen operating in someone else's life? How have you benefited from it?

Why is it so vital to remember that our spiritual gifts are for the benefit of others rather than ourselves?

The Holy Spirit's activity in our life is a gift from God.

The word Paul uses for these gifts in 1 Corinthians 12 means "grace gifts".
