"Forget the former things...I am doing a new thing!" Isaiah 43:18-19

A, B, C of Salvation:

1. Admit you have sinned. “For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.” Romans 3:23 NLT

2. Believe Jesus is God’s Son who died for your sins. “For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.” John 3:16 NLT

3. Confess that Jesus is your Lord. “If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.” Romans 10:9 NLT

Water Baptism:

Matthew 28:19–20 NLT- **“Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”**

Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11; Luke 3:21-22 Jesus set the example for all His followers to be baptized.

That includes you and me. Once we’ve asked Jesus to forgive our sins and to be our Savior, we should be baptized.

When we go under the water, it’s a reminder of Jesus’ death. Going down into the water reflects how we die to our selfish wants and leave that old life and our sins behind us. When we come up from the water, it’s a reminder of how Jesus rose from the dead. When we do this, we are rising to a new life with Jesus.

Baptism is about leaving our old life behind and showing the world we are committing to our new life with Jesus.
